Welcome to our 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Golf Tournament fundraiser to benefit the Monmouth Firehouse Museum and 9/11 Memorial Park

Golf registration fee (\$100.00) for this event covers the cost of green fees, carts, goodies bags & lunch. All money raised from hole sponsors, the score enhancement package, 50/50 raffle and putting contest will benefit the Monmouth Firehouse Museum and 9/11 Memorial Park – Thank you for your support!

Registration is from 0700-0800 am with a shotgun start at 0830 am

## Putting contest on practice green (throughout the day) – \$5.00 per person

3 balls per person – Players and non-players are welcome to participate A playoff will be held at end of event for any tied participants (1 ball only) Winner receives a special prize (TBD)

### 50/50 Raffle - \$1.00 each, 6 for \$5.00 or arm length for \$10.00

Winning ticket will be drawn at end of event just prior to awards (must be present to win)

### Score Enhancement Package - \$50 per team

Limit of 8 mulligans (2 per player) Golden Tee (only to be used on one par 5 – all players can Tee up their  $2^{nd}$  shot) String on greens (use to measure ball to hole to count stroke & cut after each use)

Prizes to be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place (Gross & Net scores)

Prizes for closest to the pin (men & women) - Mulligans can't be used

Prizes for longest drive (men & women) - Mulligans can't be used Ball must be in the fairway (or on the green if you are Tiger Woods) Please make sure you have the correct marker before moving it

Be prepared to play golf, keep up with pace and don't waste time searching for lost balls Please replace divots and repair ball marks
Course rules apply (see score card or the pro shop for additional rules)

Make sure to turn in your team's score card immediately after finishing your round so scores can be tallied

Lunch will be provided outdoors by the clubhouse's outside deck during the tournament

A beverage cart with beer, wine, soda and small snacks will either be roaming or will be situated on the course (TBA) – NO coolers or pre-bought alcoholic beverages are allowed.
